

The Love of God and the Fallacy of Spiritual Socialism

We recognize the foolishness of the Socialist agenda, e.g. decriminalizing illegal immigration so illegal immigration will not be illegal.

We understand in the natural that refusing to adhere to the rules of a game results in confusion and an uncertain outcome, and spoils the purpose of the game itself. (education, enjoyment)

But do we truly understand the destruction wrought in our lives when we fail to apply the same standard to our spiritual lives?

John 3:10-21: The Love of God properly expounded

- Most only quote John 3:16a in support of their error.
 - The rest of the passage however properly defines and expounds on the false idea of an all tolerant God who accepts people as they are.
 - Thus they avoid vs. 18-21 like the plague
- The love of God includes the condemnation that most of mankind are already under.
- Tolerance and “acceptance as is” are not included in God’s love of the world (Benevolence, pity)

I heard a man state while playing the victim, that “no one man should be allowed to define the love of God” (in order to criticize a preacher who expounded the love of God by the totality of Scripture). He then quoted and twisted out of context John 3:16a and then proceeded to define the love of God. I suppose His initial statement didn’t apply to himself. Total, complete hypocrisy and damnable error.

- They ignore large sections of Scripture
- They Change the word to satiate their error and disobedience, and distort the Character of God.
- They redefine God’s terms (e.g. “love”) to mean something other than
